Your application requires the following ***three attachments*** in order to be considered:

1. **Your Biosketch** (*no more than 1 page*): Full name. Contact details. A bit about your background and interests. Which Winterim India course did you participate in? Who was your course instructor? What were your travel dates? Which cities did you visit?
2. **Travel Receipts**: A copy of your air ticket and boarding passes
3. **Your Perspectives** (*no more than 1-2 pages, single-spaced, 12 pt font*):
 - ❖ **DESCRIBE** any aspect of **your experiences** in any sector (e.g., healthcare, housing, social work, women's empowerment and financial independence, performing arts, education, physical therapy & rehab, water resources, solid waste collection and disposal, ecotourism, renewable energy, and mobile apps/telecommunications).
 - ❖ **SHARE** any **next-steps** for your career; or **plans for collaborative undertakings** to support your job-creation ideas for people in the US and India (e.g., gather champions for your endeavors; attract philanthropic funding; craft new business concepts, start your own company, seek angel investors for incubation and scale-up, etc.).
 - ❖ **EXPRESS** in a paragraph **your own longer-term aspirations** and why it is meaningful to you to have **an affiliation with a nonprofit like CARTHA** (meaning *doer* in Sanskrit) with a mission of Cultivating Collaborative Doers who link academic research translation to human endeavors enhancing ***glocal*** (global and local) good.
 - ❖ **CONFIRM** that you enjoy **speaking to wider audiences** outside of your own professional realms or comfort zones. CARTHA Fellows participate in our *Glocalizer* forums (whether in the US or elsewhere) along **with other Carthans**—scientists, artists, physicians, entrepreneurs, writers, scholars, filmmakers, engineers, and public citizens—at social service clubs, high schools, museums, campus seminars, and professional society gatherings.
